Happy summer to my church family!

I would like to update you on what we are accomplishing on Session.

First, as you likely know already, our Bell Choir Director Jack Salter accepted a full time position in California. So, the search is on for his replacement. The opportunity will be advertised.

This fall, we are discussing the possibility of having a "mission opportunities fair," perhaps in conjunction with Rally Day. The fair would introduce people to the plethora of ways the congregation may live out their faith lives. This fair is in direct response to the congregational survey taken last year. One of the results of the survey indicated that a large percentage of regular attendees to worship services are not otherwise engaged by church activities.

Discussion continues on the needs of the building and church property. The two biggest projects are the reconstruction of the creek's break wall to the south of the church, and the resealing of the oldest bricks of our building. A special sub-committee has been set up comprised of both Session and Trustee members to discern the best way to resolve and pay for these projects. Also, bids are being accepted to seal the blacktop driveway.

There is a new, young families group starting. The first gathering is June 25 at Pastor Gregg's house, 20 Gibson Street. And of course, Vacation Bible School was held on June 20 – 24.

The finance committee sent out Request For Proposals (RFPs) to local financial managers. The committee is looking for more expertise and engagement from a money manager for our various investments.

Session will have a meeting in June, but we are taking July off. We will resume our work in August. Have a blessed summer season!
