First and foremost, I am so happy to report that Debbie Rogers and her son, Zach Rogers, recently became new members. You may already know them well as they've attended worship for quite some time, and Zach is our dedicated percussionist in our praise band. Speaking of membership, our annual meeting will be held February 12, 2017 during the 11:00 A.M. worship service. One of the rooms in the basement known as the "Scout Room" is suffering from water damage. Every time it rains, or snow melts, water leaks down into this room. It is coming from the planter box that is built up against the east church wall. The estimated cost to stop the leaking and repair the damage is between \$13,000-\$15,000. This is not a project that can be put off, so session agreed to use money from investments to address the problem as soon as possible.

Pauline Fisher and her Membership Development committee have been working diligently to update the membership directory. There have been many address changes since the last time this was done. Doty Wagner and the Fellowship committee will be hosting a sing-a-long with Bob Shorts on January 15, 2017 at 6 P.M. There will be light refreshments provided. Abby Johnson and the Finance committee have been pursuing the idea of finding a professional money manager to manage the church's investments. The goal is to hire an expert to yield a greater consistency in returns, and not rely on a revolving door of volunteers to manage the funds. On January 14 from 9 A.M. to Noon, the actively serving Elders and Deacons will be going through their annual training. This training is required by *The Book of Order*, and addresses the tenets of the Reformed faith as well as polity.

While the venue is still in the planning stages, Pastor David Hansen has agreed to preach on March 11, 2018 as part of the program.
