THE PASTOR'S PEN

Once upon a time there was a roofer who was hired to repair a high and steep roof. Worse still, the shingles were made of old slate which, over the course of time, had become slippery because moss had grown over much of it. The roofer put his

satchel of tools over his back and then, step by step, ascended the ladder onto the roof. At the top of the ladder he grabbed hold of the gutter and pulled his body onto the roof. He then crawled to the top of the roof and, once there, decided to try and stand so that he could survey the damage that needed repairing. Carefully, he kneeled. Then he started to stand. Without realizing it, however, he'd planted his foot on a patch of slimy moss which suddenly gave way. In that split second, he fell face first and sped quickly down the roof on his stomach! He extended his arms and hands quickly to try and grab hold of something – anything – in a desperate effort to save himself from falling off the roof, but he could find nothing to grasp. The speed of his slide only increased. Then, at the very last moment, with his legs and torso already off the roof and on their way to the pavement below, he made one last desperate attempt to reach for the roof. As he did, the tips of his fingers found the rain gutter. He hung on for dear life, and that was when he said, "This is the part of the job I hate."

Well, this is the part of the job I hate. This is the part where I need to speak with you about money and the ways in which you are called by God to financially support the work of our congregation's ministry. This month's article is the fourth in a series regarding some of the critical needs in the life of our congregation. In previous months, we've addressed topics such as the need for consistent worship attendance and personal involvement in the many ministry opportunities of our congregation. Today, however, we need to talk dollars and cents.

Every member is called to make a joyous and generous financial commitment to our congregation. Every member should participate financially according to the Bible's instruction. *God commands that we give 10% of our income.* Malachi 3:10 says, "Bring the full tithe into the storehouse [the Temple]..." Jesus assumed that his followers would tithe. The practice of some members of the earliest church was to hold all of their wealth in common! (That verse from Acts scares me a little!]

Here's the reality of our situation: The majority of our members make no financial pledge commitment at all. Of those who do give, the average amount is about 1% of their income. [The Presbyterian Church (USA) average is 2%]. The typical member in our congregation gives considerably less than 1% of their income.

It's not a matter of how much you make. Cash is tight for everyone! Just be faithful. God promises to meet all your needs. We can all give just one dollar out of every ten we make. Should we do so, the doors will open for us to carry out some astonishing mission and caregiving activities in Jesus' name. Also, if you need help in planning your finances we will be offering Financial Peace University again this year.

I am told that the great Reformer Martin Luther once said, "There are three conversions necessary [for the Christian life]: the conversion of the heart, the mind, and the purse." I ask you to show your faith with your money and be obedient to God. He will bless you richly if you do!


